GENERAL INFORMATION

The entry fee is \$25 per class if we receive your entries by Wednesday prior to each show. For entries received after Wednesday, the entry fee is \$30 per class.

A \$20 awards fee, \$10 paramedic fee, and \$5 office fee per show will be required for each horse/rider combination.

Chaps and paddock boots are acceptable. If the weather is cold, warm jackets are encouraged. Show coats are not required.

Riders must wear protective hard hats at all times while mounted. Please be sure use of tack (nose bands, bits, martingales, etc.) strictly adheres to USEF rules.

Horse/rider combinations may not cross-enter into divisions with more than 6" height difference. There is **no** restriction regarding **horses with different riders** cross-entering into divisions with more than 6" height difference. This rule does not apply to jumpers.

Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

Dogs must be on a hand-held leash at all times.

Children must be supervised by an adult.

Entries must be paid with cash or check... no other form of payment is accepted.

RELEASE REQUIREMENT

This is a new year...

All release forms for **2024** are now void. A new form for **2025** must be signed by each participant of legal age or by the parent/legal guardian of any minor for any show at Hidden Lake Farm. **Trainers may NOT sign in lieu of parents**, as this is a legal document.

Please go to hiddenlakefarm.net and download a new form for each participant! Please bring signed forms when you register.

COGGINS REQUIREMENT

Texas law requires each show facility to obtain a negative Coggins report dated within the past 12 months for each horse admitted to the show grounds. Please bring a current copy with you. Simply providing the Coggins number and date is not sufficient. We must verify that the Coggins is current and retain accurate records in the event we are audited. Any horse arriving on HLF property without a current Coggins will be required to leave the premises.

A negative Coggins report is required at registration for each show. We will not keep records from one show to the next in this or future series. Cell phone reports are acceptable.

Thank you for your support of our mandatory compliance with this Texas state law.

SATURDAY SCHOOLING

Schooling is open 9:00-4:00 on Saturdays for those participating in the show (no fee required). For those not in the show, the cost is \$40. Riders must deposit a signed a release in the envelope on the registration table before schooling on Saturday. Releases will be available on the registration table.

HLF is always open 7 days a week for schooling. The cost is \$40 per horse rider combination, and you may stay as long as you like. **Please email us at hiddenlakefarm@gmail.com to schedule schooling.**

Rules for End-of-Series Competition

Requirements for Division Championships

- The division must be held with at least 3 entries in at least 3 shows. This applies even if one or more show(s) is canceled due to weather.
- Warmup classes are optional and points do not count for series championships.

Rules for Divisions I-III (Equitation Divisions)

- Points go to the rider, not the horse.
- The rider is not required to ride the same horse in order for points to accrue for the series championship.
- The rider must participate in all 3 classes (exclusive of the warmup class) in the same division in at least 3 shows. There must be at least 3 riders in all 3 classes in the division in order for points to accrue for the division championship.

Rules for Divisions IV-VIII (Hunter Divisions)

- Points go the horse, not the rider.
- The horse may be ridden by different riders and the points will accrue for the championship.
- The horse must participate in all 3 classes (exclusive of warmup) in the same division in at least 3 shows. There must be at least 3 horses in each class in the division in order for points to accrue.
- Points in the equitation classes do not count toward end of series championship.

Rules for Divisions IX-XI (Jumper Divisions)

- Points go the horse, not the rider.
- The horse may be ridden by different riders and the points will accrue for the championship.
- The horse must participate in all 3 classes (exclusive of warmup) in the same division in at least 3 shows. There must be at least 3 horses in each class in the division in order for points to accrue for the division championship.


